REGISTRY UPDATES

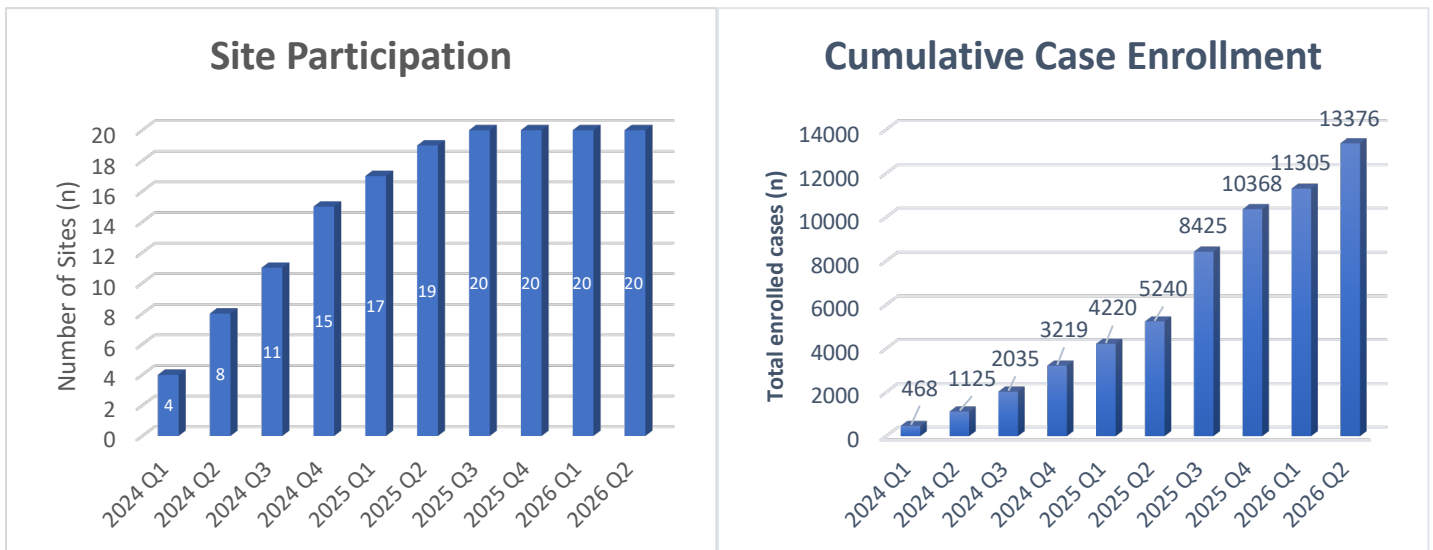
- Version 3.3 protocol — Several sites still require IRB amendment to participate under the updated protocol.
- CRISP Score now available for local EPIC implementation.
- CRISP Radiation Exposure Category is now launched in the DAP/kg benchmark comparison interface.
- AE adjudication notification system is now activated — finalized adjudication results are shared directly with participating sites.

RESEARCH

- Retrospective study: IntraStent LD Mega/Max on pulmonary artery — Led by Dr. Greg Fleming (Duke University). The first study utilizing the PA stent module embedded in the CRISP registry. Twelve centers enrolled; currently in case volume inquiry stage.

EVENTS & ADMINISTRATION

- 2nd CRISP Registry Webinar — Summer 2026. Invited speaker: Dr. Gareth Morgan (Children's Hospital of Colorado).
- CCISC Meeting at PICS 2026 — Please join. A dinner session for CRISP registry participants is also being planned. More details to follow.

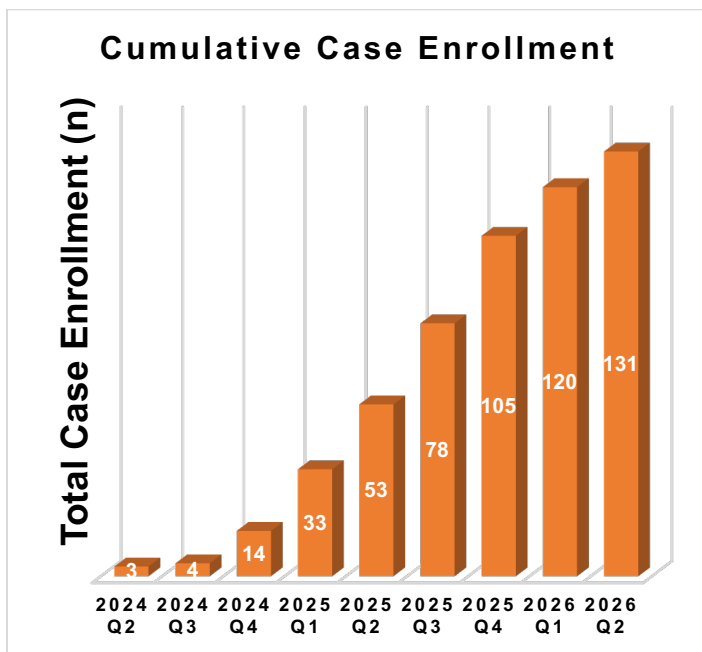
