
#### **Highlights**

- CRISP Investigator Dinner at PICS 2025, Chicago
- Occlutech ASD Module: Enrolled 75 cases across 11 centers to date. Site-specific contract negotiations with Occlutech have been initiated for funding support.
- Rapid Enrollment Growth: Surpassed 8,000 enrolled cases.
- Expanding Site Participation: St. Joseph Children's Hospital, Tampa is now ready to begin case enrollment.




#### What's Next


