

**Subject:** CRISP Registry – New TPVI Procedure Type Selections

Transcatheter pulmonary valve implantation (TPVI) is a common procedure in the CRISP registry. The current procedure type “**Transcatheter valve implantation / Pulmonary**” includes both balloon- and self-expanding valves. To improve data accuracy, two new procedure type options have been created:

Current selection	New selection (Effective Nov 1, 2025)
Transcatheter valve implantation / Pulmonary	Transcatheter valve implantation / Pulmonary (balloon expanding)
	Transcatheter valve implantation / Pulmonary (self expanding)

Valve Type Reference

- Balloon expanding: Melody, Sapien
- Self expanding: Harmony, Alterra Prentent, Venous-P

Important Notes:

1. Please discontinue use of “Transcatheter valve implantation / Pulmonary” after November 1, 2025.
2. The registry team will update existing entries based on valve type information.
